

## 2016 ALL-STAR TEAM APPLICATION PACKET

**Date of Meet:** January 17-18, 2016

**Location:** UCSD- Canyonview Aquatic Facility

**Meet Format:** 2 Day Dual Meet against the Sierra Nevada All-Star Team  
(format to be published on SI website once finalized by Sierra Nevada LSC)

**Entry Procedure:** OPEN ENROLLMENT to all San Diego Imperial swimmers who are registered for the 2016 swim season. Interested swimmers must submit a completed All-Star packet, along with a team enrollment fee of \$100.00. Please make the check payable to San Diego Imperial Swimming. If an applicant is not selected for the team, the check will be shredded. For the All-Star meet, each swimmer will compete in up to three individual events each day (events selected by the coaching staff), as well as two relays.

**Entry Deadline:** Completed applications MUST be submitted to Mary Redmond in the Admin office by the conclusion of the Sunday preliminaries session at Winter Age Group Championships (Dec 20).

**Team Selection Notification:** Every effort will be made to notify all applicants of the selection status by 8:00PM, Tuesday, Dec 22, 2015.

**Team Selection Criteria:** Eight girls and eight boys from the designated age groups (10&U, 11-12, and 13-14) will be selected for the team. Based on the performance of the swimmers' best six finishes at the Winter Age Group Championships in events that are to be swum at the All Star Meet (designated in WAGs format with a star), the following criteria will be used:

- Two first place finishes among SI swimmers in an event – automatic qualification.
- Single first place finishers fill the remaining slots (max of 8), with next highest place finish being used (if necessary) as a tie breaker.
- If still less than 8 have qualified, scores will be awarded in swimmers' best six qualifying races and the lowest scores will fill the remaining spots on the roster. IMX scoring will be used. Scores will be given to non-participants in the meet who competed in another SI swim meet in December (Coronado or NCAA/ B meet) .

*Note: Coaching staff reserves the right to select team in the event of circumstances beyond those described above.*

**Team Attire:** Each member of the All Star team will receive a team swim cap and team t-shirt. Swimmers are expected to race in a solid black or navy swim suit during the meet (tech suits excluded), and wear the team attire at all required times.

**Team Meeting:** Date and Location to be announced. If arrangements can be made, we will try to have a team practice where swimmers can meet each other and All-Star attire will be distributed.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

This code of conduct shall apply to all those representing San Diego-Imperial Swimming.

The following shall be prohibited at all times:

1. Possession of, use of, or knowledge of use of illegal substances by those representing SI Swimming or use in the presence of those representing SI Swimming.
2. Inappropriate or destructive behavior, or knowledge (without immediate reporting) of same.
3. Smoking by athletes (or use of other tobacco products) while representing SI Swimming. Knowledge of use is to be considered use (unless immediately reported.)
4. Use by athletes, knowledge of use of, or providing alcohol to or use around swimmers. Use of alcohol by those having direct responsibility for swimmers is also prohibited. Violation by any representative of the laws, regulations, rules, etc is included.

Note: Persons present while any of the above mentioned prohibited activities occur must leave the area immediately and report the situation immediately to the Team Manager, a coach or chaperone or considered to be a participant by choice.

### **Team Expectations**

The following are mandatory and the responsibility of the Head Coach or designee:

1. All athletes and individuals need to remember that they are representing San Diego Imperial swimming with their attire, behavior and attitude.
2. Coaches and athletes must attend all team meetings and/or required functions.
3. The Team Manager/Head Coach shall have in his possession a signed "Consent to Treat" form for all minors on the trip.

Further, all swimmers who have been designated as part of the team representing SI Swimming are to remain as part of that team from the time of warm-up until the end of the daily activity. The swimmers must at all times follow the team staff's instructions as it relates to swimming, meals, team meetings, social events or any other incidentals or directions that may be given.

A swimmer can only be released by his/her parents prior to completion of Sunday evening events if such release has been requested in writing by the parent and addressed to and received by the Team Manager at least 48 hours prior to the swim meet. If approval for early release is granted by the Team Manager, such approval will be provided to the parent(s) in writing and signed by the Team Manager. Verbal approval will not be given or accepted.
