This meet has been sanctioned by San Diego Imperial Swimming and current USA Swimming rules and any relevant sections of the San Diego Imperial Policies & Procedures Manual will apply. All swimmers must be registered as athletes for 2023 with USA Swimming by the meet entry deadline. San Diego Imperial Swimming does not allow on-deck USA Swimming registrations. Conduct of the sanctioned event shall conform in every respect to all technical and administrative rules of USA Swimming.

Eligibility	This is a closed meet, open only to the All-Star teams of each participating LSC. All swimmers must have current USA swimming registration as of the meet entry deadline. Each All-Star team will be composed of a maximum of 8 athletes per age group and gender (10&UN, 11-12, 13-14) for a maximum total of 48 athletes per team. Teams may not go over capacity in one age group/gender by going under in another. Team may elect to have 1 swimmer per age group per gender to be used as an alternate.

Deck Entries:	No Deck Entries allowed.
MAAPP:	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All 18 and older athletes registered with the club must have completed the Athlete Protection Training. Failing to complete the APT test will impact the athlete's ability to compete at meets or have their times loaded into SWIMS
Safe Sport:	At this time swimmers, coaches, workers, officials, and parents will be allowed in the pool area. There may be designated area(s) for athletes, coaches, and meet personal.
Venue:	Granite Hills High School, 1719 E Madison Ave El Cajon CA 92019 The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 5 feet, 6 inches at the start end and 3 feet, 0 inches at the turn end. Snack bar may be available.

Facility:	There may be designated area(s) for athletes, coaches, and meet personal.
Water Depth:	The pool has 17 working lanes with a warmup area available. The minimum water depth measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 6 feet, 0 inches at the start end and 3 feet, 6 inches at the turn end.
Course Certification	The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).
USA Swimming Registration:	All swimmers, coaches, and officials participating in this competition must be <u>currently</u> (2024) registered with USA Swimming and in good standing. All Coaches are required to complete the USADA Coaching Advantage, and all officials and coaches are to have completed CANRA and Concussion Protocol Training. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. All swimmers must be registered as athletes for 2024 with USA Swimming by the meet entry deadline. It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
Meet Format:	Flyover starts may be used.
Clerk of Course (Check-in Procedures).	This meet will be pre-seeded. Any changes to the meet lineup will be made with the meet admin and meet referee prior to the swimming of the event.
Meet Start Time:	Saturday: warm up 2:30, meet starts 4:00 PM Sunday: warm up 7:30, meet starts 9:00 AM
Age Up Date:	The age of the swimmer will be the swimmers age on January 6, 2024.
Restrictions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each All-Star team will be composed of a maximum of 8 swimmers per age group and gender; teams are allowed to have 1 alternate swimmer per age group/gender; (10/under, 11/12, 13/14) for a maximum of 54 swimmers per team. Teams may not go over capacity in one age group/gender by going under in another. • Each LSC may enter up to 4 swimmers in each event. • No swimmer may compete in more than 3 individual events and 2 relay events per day. • Each LSC may enter up to 2 relay teams in each relay event. • This meet will be pre-seeded. • Time Trials will not be offered. • Alternates may be used when a swimmer in the same age group/gender are not able to swim • Alternates will be allowed to swim as exhibition swimmers for up to 3 individual events per day. <p>This is a closed meet and is only open to SI and AZ swimmers on their all-star team.</p>
Other Restrictions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There may be separate restroom facilities for athletes and coaches/ officials / spectators. • Shaving is not allowed anywhere in the facility • Tobacco products of any kind, vaping, alcohol beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. • Trained service animals or service animals in training with identifiable vests will be

	allowed. Service animals must remain on a leash or be always in a harness.
Cell phone restrictions:	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms and behind the start area behind the blocks.
Drone Restrictions:	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) at any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
Deck Changing:	Deck changes are prohibited. Teams are encouraged to bring and use the Safe Sport changing tent.
12 & under Tech Suit Restriction:	102.8.1.F SWIMWEAR (USA Swimming Rulebook) No Technical Suits Shall be worn by any 12 & under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved or observed meet. (as of 9/1/2020).
Racing start Certification:	Any Athlete entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the athlete or athletes' legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
Officials:	Officials will be scheduled in advance with the minimum number of officials required set by the Officials Chair. All deck officials must be registered with USA Swimming for 2023 and have a current Background Check, Athlete Protection Course, CANRA, and Concussion Protocol Training acknowledged by USA Swimming.
Timers:	Two Parent Volunteers per lane will be assigned to work back up buttons and stop watches.
USA Swimming Meet 360:	<p>Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming Membership.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming membership (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted. ▪ Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands. ▪ Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also be made to USA Swimming. ▪ A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate in this competition. ▪ Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party.
