DATES: Friday, July 19, 2024-Short Course/25-yard pool configuration

Sat and Sun, July 20-21, 2024-Long Course/50-meter pool configuration

SITE: University of California at San Diego Canyonview Aquatic Center, 3390 Voigt Drive, San Diego, 92121. The pool is 8 lanes 50 meter x 25 yards. The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 7 feet, 0 inches at the start end and 7 feet, 0 inches at the turn end.

All registered athletes receive a credential in the athlete packet.

ENTRY FEES & DEADLINES:

\$25 for first event if registered by May 31, 2024

\$30 for first event if registered between June 1 – June 30, 2024

\$35 for first event if registered between May 1 – July 10, 2024

Each additional event is \$7

During registration, participants will be asked if they are a USA Swim Member. If the answer is yes, please select yes. You will be charged an additional \$5 fee (required by USA Swimming).

No-onsite registration will be accepted. Swimmers can register for 6 events plus relays each day. Relays can be deck-entered at the event.

Events will be seeded together in ages and scored/awarded separately. Events will run females first, followed by males.

AWARDS: State Games of America Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in all events, including relays.

AWARD DIVISIONS: 8 & Under; 9-10; 11-12; 13-14; 15-18; 19-24; 25 & Over as awarded in Masters Events below

Masters events are listed as 25-0. They will be combined ages for swimming, and separated in normal 5 year increments for awards (25-29, 30-34...).

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules will be used. US Masters Swimming rules will prevail where noted.

Water Depth: The pool has an 8 lane 50-meter x 25-yard pool. The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 7 feet, 0 inches at the start end and 7 feet, 0 inches at the turn end. Additional warm-up lanes will be available in the secondary pool.

Course Certification The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

Guidelines: The competition: This meet will be held using the most current State, County, Local, and Facility guidelines that are in place on the day(s) of the event.
